- It is unlikely a reasonable settlement will be obtained or the amount in dispute is disproportionate to the time and legal costs involved in its pursuit
- Any legal costs or expenses incurred without prior written authorisation or incurred as a result of significant default or delay on the policyholders part
- Such legal costs and expenses for claims which arise from a criminal act or omission
- Applications for judicial review or in respect of the Human Rights Act or proceedings forming part of a group or multi-party action
- Prior to the issue of any proceedings the policyholder must use the representative or solicitor nominated and appointed by the insurer
- In no case will we pay more than £50,000
